We offer various types of treatment, depending on your individual orthodontic situation. The following is a typical sequence of treatment; specific cases may vary.

1. Records appointment - diagnostic records, which includes photography and x-rays (1 to 1 1/2 hours)
2. Beginning treatment – banding/bonding (approximately 1 hour)
3. Oral hygiene appointment (30 minutes)
4. Regular adjustment appointments – scheduled at twelve-week intervals throughout active treatment time (1/2 hour each)
5. Completion of treatment - debanding (1/2 hour)
6. After records, which includes photography/post-treatment consult (1 hour)
7. Retainer checks (30 minutes)

The extensive training and experience of Drs. Rogers, Duncan & Dillehay and their staff is your assurance that you or your child will receive the specialized attention you deserve.

Oral hygiene appointments are important. Please see your family dentist regularly for routine checkups.

A treatment progress report is available upon request.

At any stage of treatment, please feel free to ask questions. Parents are always welcome to accompany their child to the chair.

If you break or lose a retainer, please remember that only initial retainers are included in the case fee for full treatment; replacement retainers are provided for an additional fee. The retainer will be checked for two years following full orthodontic treatment. After two years, there will be an office visit charge. There may be a retainer check charge following Phase I treatment.
